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## Peterborough BMX Club

### CLUB RULES

The rules are for the safety of all riders and must be adhered to

- Your bike must be in good working order
- All protruding bike accessories must be removed
- Helmet and gloves must be worn when on the track
- Full length jerseys and trousers are essential
- Bike pads and body pads are recommended.
- You must always ride the correct way round the track
- Do not stop in the middle of the track (move to the side)

## What is BMX racing.

BMX racing is an extremely exciting, fast growing and sociable sport. Up to eight riders race around a 300 - 400 metre track, with jumps and berms (banked corners), in a moto cross style. It is open to riders of all ages, boys and girls making it great fun for all the family. BMX is a very sociable event and great for all the family, even those that don't race...

You can compete at both Regional level and National level. Each region consists of a number of clubs/tracks and each season some of these tracks will hold a regional event. These are known as rounds and these all go towards your regional ranking and qualifying to race at the British Championships at the end of the season. There are both Summer and Winter series racing events.



National level - There are on average 6 National events and these are double headers raced over a weekend. These are of a much higher level, but are a wonderful experience and a



As a novice rider you can compete in 3 Regional races without a British Cycling Race Licence and membership, however if you want to continue and participate at other Regional races and National events a Race licence will be required.
